Ever since her arrival in September 2009 Mary Barclay - a Wycliffe Theological student - has been on a mission and we have all been the better for it.

Right now she is with a mission team in *Gambia*. Prior to this challenge, Mary has been serving closer to home contributing to the lives of the Anglicans of St Clair West as Student Assistant at the Church of St Mark and Calvary.

Church School members (young and older!) all enjoyed Mary's opening "Childrens' Focus" each Sunday. Mary was also the preacher on several Sundays in both parishes, and assisted in Holy Week services as well as the regular liturgies.

In Lent Mary was the co-leader with Carol Lewis of a joint study "Mission Possible" exploring ways for us to identify and engage in God's mission in our midst and in the wider community.

Mary has also been a careful listener and a perceptive observer of our parish life. She has shared her insights in a Report and, upon her return from *Gambia*, will be engaged in consultations with the leadership team of St Mark and Calvary in discerning the way forward.

Mary has asked for our prayers during the mission to *Gambia* and her summer placement at St Mark's, Midland, Ontario. Together with petitions for safety and success in these ministries we can surely add thanksgiving for her time with us and prayers for her return in the fall
